Resurfacing Butcher Block Counter Tops with PaperIllusion®

MATERIALS NEEDED

- PaperIllusion®, your choice
- Butcher Block Counter Top
- Sandpaper
- Bowl w/warm water
- Terry-cloth towel/washcloth
- Wallpaper Primer
- Water-based Polyurethane (non-yellowing)

SURFACE PREPARATION

- 1. Surface should be clean and free of dirt, grease or mildew.
- 2. Lightly sand the counter top just enough so you could feel the scuff marks.
- 3. Wipe off all dust residues.
- 4. Apply wallpaper primer and let dry.

APPLYING PaperIllusion®

- 1. Tear PaperIllusion® into irregular pieces.
- 2. Dip each piece into water; shake off excess water, and then press onto surface, blot with a paper towel to remove excess water.

***TIP**: Start papering the edges of the countertop with the straight edge of the roll(s) first. Then fill in the middle with the torn pieces.

- 3. Apply another piece, slightly overlapping the edge of the previous piece.
- 4. Continue to tear, dip and apply PaperIllusion®.
- 5. When completed, check the entire surface to be sure there are no bumps or air bubbles. Squeegee the paper smooth (with a credit card or some type of smoothing tool) or remove and reapply. Allow to dry for at least 24 hours.

FINISHING

- 1. Select a water-based polyurethane from your local craft store or home center.
- 2. Using an all-purpose paintbrush brush on one light coat over PaperIllusion® and let dry (about 1 hour). Repeat this until you have a minimum of 4 coats.
