

# Resurfacing Commercial Tile Flooring with PaperIllusion®

## MATERIALS NEEDED

- PaperIllusion®, your choice
- Commercial Tile Flooring
- Sandpaper
- Bowl w/warm water
- Terry-cloth towel/washcloth
- Wallpaper Primer
- Water-based Polyurethane (satin finish was used)

## SURFACE PREPARATION

1. Surface should be clean and free of dirt, grease or mildew.
2. Apply wallpaper primer and let dry.

## APPLYING PaperIllusion®

1. Tear PaperIllusion® into irregular pieces.
2. Dip each piece into water; shake off excess water, and then press onto surface, blot with a paper towel to remove excess water.

**\*TIP:** Start papering the edges of the room with the straight edge of the roll(s) first. Then fill in the middle with the torn pieces.

3. Apply another piece, slightly overlapping the edge of the previous piece.
4. Continue to tear, dip and apply PaperIllusion®. When finished, let dry completely.

## FINISHING

1. Select a water-based polyurethane from your local craft store or home center.
2. Using an all-purpose paintbrush brush on two coats over PaperIllusion® and let dry (about 1 hour).
3. Sand the surface and wipe clean of dust.
4. Apply two more coats of polyurethane over PaperIllusion® and let dry.
